Clean Energy Coal Bonds Present law Tax-exempt bonds Interest on State and local governmental bonds generally is excluded from gross income for Federal income tax purposes if the proceeds of the bonds are used to finance direct activities of these governmental units or if the bonds are repaid with revenues of the governmental units. Activities that can be financed with these tax-exempt bonds include the financing of electric power facilities (i. e. , generation, transmission, distribution, and retailing). Interest on State or local government bonds to finance activities of private persons (private activity bonds) is taxable unless a specific exception is contained in the Code (or in non-Code provision of a revenue Act). The term private person generally includes the Federal Government and all other individuals and entities other than States or local governments. The Code includes exceptions permitting States or local governments to act as conduits providing tax-exempt financing...
